These committees are designed to support the mission of PMAF by offering strategic guidance, amplifying community voice, and strengthening our programs, partnerships, and impact.

Advisory Committees are non-governing bodies that work in collaboration with the Board of Directors and staff to help shape initiatives, inform decision-making, and serve as ambassadors for PMAF's vision and values.

Committee Focus Areas

Each committee aligns with a key area of our work. Current and planned committees include:

- Honoree Selection Committee – Leads the evaluation and interview process for PMA nominees
- Fundraising & Development Committee – Supports donor outreach, events, and strategic partnerships
- Programs & Cohort Committee – Advises on honoree programming and year-round engagement
- Communications & Visibility Committee – Helps shape media, storytelling, and public engagement
- Legacy & Archives Committee – Supports the preservation and celebration of Black LGBTQ+ histories

Additional committees may be convened based on organizational need.

Member Expectations

Advisory Committee members are expected to:

- Attend virtual meetings (typically quarterly or bi-monthly, depending on the committee)
- Offer expertise, insight, and feedback relevant to their committee's focus
- Champion PMAF's mission in their networks
- Serve a renewable one-year term
